

Bradley Transfer Application Instructions

This is an undergraduate application for transfer students. Students applying for readmission to Bradley University should go to our readmission application. If you are an international or graduate student, do not fill out this application. Please visit the International Admissions or Graduate School web site for more information and an application. If you do not have a bachelor's degree and would like to take a course at Bradley, but you are not seeking a degree from Bradley, visit the Non-Degree Students section of our web site.

Please take a few minutes to read all of the following information. It will be helpful to you as you complete the application process.

Bradley University requires that official copies of your college transcript(s) be sent to Bradley directly from the school(s) you have attended as well as your completed application. If you have not completed 15 transferable hours of college credit, please have an official copy of your high school transcript sent directly from your high school to Bradley.

Application Deadlines

Transfer students are encouraged to submit their application for admission as early as possible. For fall semester applicants, it is highly recommended that you submit your application for admission by March 1 in order to receive full consideration for scholarships and financial assistance.

Scholarships and Financial Assistance

All students who apply for admission will automatically be reviewed for scholarships based upon the content of their completed application materials. If you are eligible for scholarship assistance, you will be notified in your admission letter.

Finalizing Your Enrollment

Admitted students will be required to reserve a place in the entering class by submitting a nonrefundable \$200 enrollment fee. To be guaranteed University housing, you must also submit an additional \$100 housing deposit. All freshmen and sophomores are required to live in university housing unless they reside within commuting distance or have independent status. Enrollment fees received after May 1 will be considered on a space available basis.
