Majors in the College of Business should take Introduction to Psychology + Introduction to Sociology.

Education majors are required to take American National Government while Introduction to Psychology is (c) recommended. Education majors should see an advisor for other options.

Several majors require Calculus. Check a Bradley catalog or a Bradley advisor. History 141+142 will satisfy Bradley's WC and NW requirement (must complete both for General (e) Education credit).

Engineering and Education majors may require a general education course at the 300 level. Please consult a Bradley
