Majors in the College of Business should take Introduction to Psychology + Introduction to Sociology. Education (c) majors are required to take American National Government while Introduction to Psychology is recommended. Education majors should see an advisor for other options.

Engineering and Education majors may require a general education course at the 300 level. Please consult a Bradley advisor.
